Homeroom, Options, and Locker Day Information

We trust you had an amazing summer full of rest, adventures, and time to connect with the ones you love. The following is important information regarding Jr. High courses. A general start-up email with details regarding bell schedule, first day/week activities, and information to help you prepare for the first days of the new school year will be sent next week.

1. **Homeroom Assignments** - Homeroom placements for Grades 8 and 9 students were made collaboratively by our core teachers, administration, and our school counsellor. Similarly, the SCE team constructed the Grade 7 homeroom class lists. A variety of factors were considered in the process, including: balancing academic needs, special considerations presented by parents during the registration season, student friend requests, and general classroom composition. Therefore, homeroom placements will only be adjusted for extenuating circumstances. If you would like to discuss your child's homeroom placement, please contact Mr. Winkel.
2. **Student Schedules** - Student schedules will be able to be viewed through [student](#) and [parent](#) portals at 4pm on August 19th. *All new EIPS families do not currently have access to PowerSchool. An email will be sent with your child's schedule and PowerSchool log in details on August 19th.*
3. **Option Course Selection/Fees** – All students submitted their requests for their options courses in the spring. Additional [course information](#), including our [course handbook](#), and [course specific fees](#) can be found on our school website. All efforts were made to ensure students were given at least one of the option courses they indicated as a priority. Due to this, changes to Semester One Junior High option courses must be requested by a parent through [this form](#) by August 23rd. Mr. Winkel will notify families via email on August 24th regarding the status of their request.
4. **Locker Day** – On Thursday, August 25th, between 9am and noon, all Junior High (Grade 7-9) students are invited to visit the school to receive their locker assignments and set up their locker. All students who do not attend will be given their locker assignment and time to set up their locker on the first day of school.
