

## Junior High – School Start Up Information 2025-26 School Year

The following is important information for the upcoming 2025-2026 school year. Please make note of the key dates and information below.

- 1. Course Selection All new and current students should have already submitted their requests for their options courses. If your family has not done this, please contact Mrs. Tembo via email ASAP (alisha.tembo@eips.ca). Additional course information including our course handbook can be found on our website. Students will be able to view their schedules on August 18<sup>th</sup>. At that time, schedules will be available through student and parent portals for both Junior and Senior High. All efforts were made to ensure students were given at least one of the option courses they indicated were a priority. Changes to Junior High option courses must be requested by a parent and approved by Mr. Winkel (kevin.winkel@eips.ca). Note: families that are new to EIPS do not currently have access to PowerSchool. An email should have been sent with your PowerSchool login details (if not, please reach out).
- 2. **Locker Day** On Wednesday, August 27<sup>th</sup> all Junior High (Grade 7-9) students are welcome to come to the school to receive their locker assignments and set up their locker between 3:00 5:00 p.m. This is a great day to master the art of entering your locker, learn and review where all of your classes are, and generally get set up for a smoother first day. Students who do not attend will be given a locker and time to set up their locker on the first day of school.
